## NOTICE TO MEMBERS

By observing the following requirements and conditions members will assist the committee and add to the enjoyment and comfort of their fellow members and guests.

Members may introduce visitors subject to the conditions laid down by the committee from time to time.

Any member introducing a visitor shall be responsible for the conduct of such visitor both in the Clubhouse and on the Course.

We welcome visitors, and new members, to Bardwell Valley Golf Club. We feel that the members responsible for introducing or sponsoring such guests should see that the newcomers are introduced to the Club Officials and other members so that "The Valley" spirit and hand of friendship is properly extended and thus add to the entertainment and hospitality of everyone.

Junior members or visitors under the age of 18 years shall **NOT BE SUPPLIED** with alcohol on the Club premises.

Members should not nominate or second any person for membership of the Club unless thoroughly satisfied that such nominee is in every way worthy.

In no instance shall a servant or staff member of the Club be directly reprimanded by a member. Any complaint etc. must be made in writing and lodged with the Board of Directors.

Members are reminded that the furniture and fittings in the Clubhouse are their property and are requested to preserve and protect same.

Food or alcohol, other than that purchased at the Club, is not to be brought into the Clubhouse without permission of the Committee or General Manager.

Members and visitors shall observe proper dress and orderly conduct on the Course and within the Clubhouse at all times.

## **ATTIRE:**

### **1) Clubhouse**

All Members, Visitors & Guests are required to be dressed in a manner which in the opinion of the Committee is appropriate to the use of the Club facilities and which will not offend or embarrass other Members, Visitors or Guests present.

Dress at all times must be clean, neat and in good repair.

### **2) On the Course**

**Men:** Collared shirts, tailored shorts or trousers and other approved golf apparel must be worn at all times. Short socks are permitted.

**Women:** Collared tops or blouses, tailored shorts, skirts, pants and other approved golf apparel must be worn at all times. Short socks or sockets are permitted.

T' shirts, singlets, board shorts, football shorts, football socks,

gym wear or thong type shoes are not permitted.  
Ripple sole shoes must not be worn on the course.

NB: Exception may be made at the discretion of the Committee for "family/fun" days.

## **HANDICAPS:**

Competitors shall have an affiliated golf club handicap and shall obtain competition score cards and verify their correct handicap prior to hitting off.

## **RIGHT OF WAY ON GOLF COURSE:**

A single player has no standing and should give way to a match of any kind. If a match fails to keep its place on the course and loses more than one clear hole on the players in front it should allow the match following to pass.

**Greens staff have right of way on the course at all times. Remember they are there to improve your golfing experience.**

## **COMPETITION BOOKINGS & TEE TIMES:**

Bookings may be made via the computer kiosks located in the clubhouse or via the Pro-shop. Starting times must be strictly adhered to and **players should report to the starter at least 15 minutes prior to their scheduled tee time.**

No more than 2 Juniors are to play in any one group, unless by prior arrangement with the Captain or Match Committee.

Members are asked to carefully make any alterations concerning their own place on the time sheet. No alterations concerning other players are to be made without their prior consent. Please notify the Club Professional if you are unable to play with at least 1 hour's notice. This notice will allow other players to participate in your vacant time slot. If a member's name appears on the time sheet and they fail to cancel or arrive for play, the member may be subject to disciplinary action. This type of behaviour causes inconvenience to your fellow members.

### **MOTORISED CARTS:**

Members and visitors are requested to comply with the following conditions when hiring and using motorised carts on the Course:

- Carts must **NOT** be driven within 10 metres of any green, or between bunkers and greens, or driven onto any teeing areas (unless on designated cart paths).
- Carts must **NOT** be parked in front of greens.
- Carts must be driven slowly & carefully, avoiding slopes on which the cart could tip over.
- Avoid excessively damp or worn areas.
- Follow all directional signs and park carts in appropriate areas.
- No more than two (2) people may ride in a cart.
- When using carts, consideration must be given to other players.

## **CARD RETURNS:**

Please ensure that cards are carefully completed, checked, signed and countersigned at completion of play. Each player is responsible for entering their own score, per the gross score on their score card, into the computer as soon as possible after completing their round. Players who refuse to do so, **MAY** be suspended from playing future rounds until they are willing to do so. Players must then place their card in the box provided, otherwise they may be disqualified.

Unsigned cards and/or without handicaps will result in the player being disqualified. This applies equally to singles events and two ball teams and aggregate events held in conjunction.

All cards, even if incomplete, must be returned for handicapping purposes. Non-registered, incomplete and disqualified cards may still be used for handicapping purposes. Cards must be legible.

## **COMPETITION RULES:**

A player may not win with the same partner in any 2 ball event, other than Championship events, within a calendar month. This rule applies to both scratch and nett events.

## **TROPHIES:**

After three calendar months from date of presentation, all unclaimed trophies will revert to Club trophy stock.

## **MOBILE PHONES:**

The use of mobile phones on the course for social or business purposes is discouraged. Members who must have their mobile phones on should set them to silent so as not to disturb fellow players.

## **ETIQUETTE OF GOLF:**

Members and guests are asked to pay particular attention to the following rules of etiquette. A little thought or consideration for fellow players will add to the pleasure and enjoyment for all on the course.

- 1) No one should move, talk or stand close to or directly behind the ball or the hole when a player is addressing the ball or making a stroke.
- 2) For the purposes of speedy play, shortest hitters should tee off first regardless of whether they won the honour at the previous hole or not (excepting during Match Play, where appropriate rules must be followed).
- 3) No player should play until the group in front is out of range.
- 4) In the interest of all, players should play without delay.
- 5) A player who has incurred a penalty should intimate the fact to his opponent or marker as soon as possible.
- 6) Players, while searching for a ball, should allow other matches coming up to play through. They should signal to the players following them to pass and, having given the signal, should not continue to play their ball until

- those players have passed and are out of range. A maximum time of five minutes is allowable for searching for a lost ball. Once this time has expired the player should declare the ball lost and restart play again.
- 7) After having played out of a bunker, a player should rake the bunker appropriately.
  - 8) A player should ensure that any turf cut or displaced by him is replaced by sand at once and pressed down. All players **MUST** carry and use a sand bucket on the course when they are playing or practicing. On the putting green any pitch marks made by the player are to be repaired to the best of the player's ability.
  - 9) A player should ensure that, when dropping bags or the flag-stick on the putting green, no damage is done to the putting surface, and neither they nor their caddies damage the hole by replacing the flag-stick. The flag-stick should be properly replaced in the hole before the players leave the putting green.
  - 10) When the result of a hole has been determined, players should immediately leave the putting green and should not retry their putts or practice their putting.
  - 11) Cards should be marked on tees while other players are hitting.
  - 12) Please avoid slow play.

### **SLOW PLAY:**

It is the responsibility of the player with the lowest handicap to maintain the position of their group in the field. Should the group fail to keep up with the group ahead, it is that player's duty to

call following players through at the appropriate time. Subject to reasonable standards of safety, players should keep one shot behind the group ahead. This means:

- 1) Walking directly to your ball and standing adjacent to it (off the fairway if you are in someone's line of sight).
- 2) Assessing your shot and selecting your club while you wait and watch shots further away than yours. (It is good etiquette to closely watch where your partner's ball goes, so you can reduce time finding it.)
- 3) NOT marking your card on the green, but rather whilst you await your turn on the next tee.
- 4) Having as few practice swings as possible (2 or 3 should be sufficient).
- 5) Calling players through if you are not in a hurry or if you need time to look thoroughly for a ball (five minutes is allowed before a penalty for a lost ball applies).
- 6) Leaving your buggy past the flag on the green and preferably adjacent to the approach to the next tee.
- 7) Adopting a "hit-if-ready" philosophy from the tees also speeds up play.

The Match Committee is reluctant to impose penalties for slow play, and it is hoped that this reminder will encourage members to be more aware of their obligations to fellow members and guests.

- Stroke 1/2 of Aggregate Stroke Handicap
- Par 1/3 of Aggregate Stroke Handicap
- Stableford 1/2 of Aggregate Stroke Handicap
- Ambrose 2 person - 1/4 Combined  
3 person - 1/6 Combined  
4 person - 1/8 Combined
- American 3/8 of Aggregate Stroke Handicap

### Mixed Fourball Event

- Men Full Stroke Handicap
- Women Full Stroke Handicap – play from the Women’s Index on score card

## GENERAL CONDITIONS OF PLAY

Members should look at the Notice Board before starting play, for they are deemed to be aware of all notices, local rules, etc there posted. They should also check their handicap before starting play.

In all elimination and knockout competitions where definite dates have been set down for playing subsequent rounds, matches must be played on or before the days set down – failure to do so, player will forfeit.

In the event of two or more players returning equal scores in a competition the winner shall be decided as follows:

- a) Playoffs in all championship events to be decided by Match Committee.
- b) All other events on the count-back method.

The lowest handicap player in each group is to be held responsible for the general conduct and progress of such group in the course of a round.

Players must commence their competition round from the 1st tee unless otherwise instructed or authorised by a member of the Match Committee or Starter.

In playing to a hole give preference to players on fairways being played.

Ladies Day is Thursday. Lady members have the right of the course during the competition period set down.

Never give details of best score returned to any competitor still playing on the course.

Competitions set down to be played in Threes or Fours should be played under these conditions, unless specified permission has been obtained from a member of the Match Committee.
